Permitted

Shirts

Sleeveless and mock collar golf design shirts allowed

Trousers / shorts

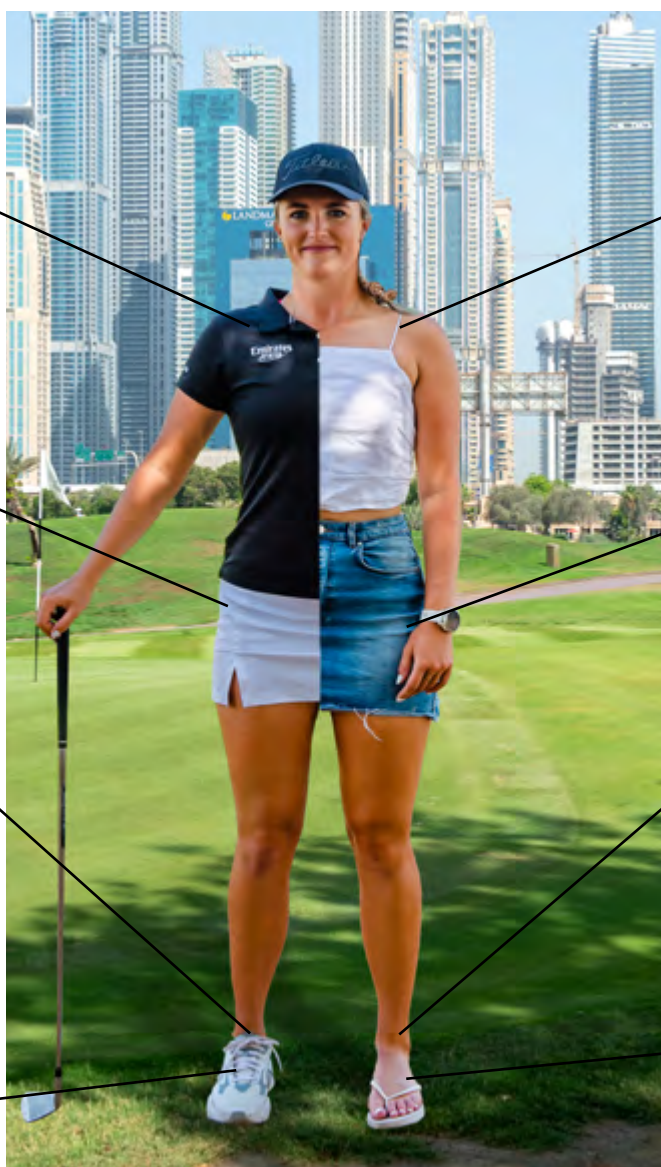
Golf dresses
Pants, shorts, skorts or similar

Socks

Long, ankle and trainer socks

Shoes

Golf shoes with soft spikes or flat soled training shoes



Not Permitted

Shirts

Round neck t-shirts without collar
Vests and National Dress
Football tshirts
Drawstring & strapless tops

Trousers / shorts

Denim
Cargo trousers/shorts
Poolwear

Socks

No socks

Shoes (Due to terrain of land and to promote safety)

Flip flops / sandals
Open shoes
Smart shoes

If improperly dressed, golfers will be respectfully asked to change to proper attire. Failure to comply with the dress code may result in access being denied to the course and/or driving range.
