



# EMIRATES GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE

## Par 3 Course

Like any prestigious golf club in the world, Emirates Golf Club has its own Dress Code requirements to reflect its proud status. While this is the case, it is also important to acknowledge that with Topgolf and the Par 3 course being routes into the game of golf, the dress code should reflect this.

### Permitted

#### Shirts

T-shirts with or without a collar  
Not required to be tucked in  
Football/sport tops allowed  
Drawstring / sleeveless tops

#### Trousers / shorts

Cargo/combat  
Denim skirts, shorts etc.  
Gym shorts / leggings

#### Socks

Long, ankle and trainer socks

#### Shoes

Golf shoes and trainers  
Sports shoes



### Not Permitted

#### Shirts

Vests and National Dress  
Strapless Tops

#### Trousers / shorts

Beachwear & Sun dresses

#### Socks

No socks

#### Shoes (Due to terrain of land and to promote safety)

Flip flops / sandals  
Open shoes  
Smart shoes

If improperly dressed, golfers will be respectfully asked to change to proper attire. Failure to comply with the dress code may result in access being denied to the Par 3 course and/or being asked to leave the course.
